

Actera and its partner in the Amazon region have developed TeraSerum Jagua around the pillars of fair trade, community development, and sustainable ecological sourcing. This program is certified by the Union for Ethical Biotrade and operates in compliance with rigorous biocommerce principals.

Financial & Social Impact

Jagua fruit is grown and harvested in partnership with five Columbian communities, many of which are located in areas of compromised economic and political security. Through these partnerships, 709 family suppliers are offered financial stability and entrepreneurial skill-building opportunities while being trained in safe and sustainable growing practices. Jagua farming initiatives contribute to a 50-75% monthly increase in family income and create 760+ new rural jobs.

Environmental & Ecological Responsibility

Jagua is sustainably-sourced from both native and forestry project trees, all of which are marked and GPS located. Supply practices guarantee fair prices for all contributors, are regulated for the sustainable use of natural resources, and follow established carbon-offsetting standards. All supply is maintained in compliance with UEBT, CDI, and Nagoya Protocol and production is regularly audited by environmental authorities.
